We need Standby Election Officials to:

- Show strong teamwork; each working with approximately 8 – 10 Election Officials assigned to a polling location.
- Attend a mandatory training session and be available to work if one of the Election Officials hired cannot work on Election Day or on the dates of the Advance Poll.

Standby Election Officials must remain non-partisan on all political views until after the day of the election. You must have the ability to strictly observe secrecy with respect to any and all knowledge that may come into the Election Official's possession as set out in [FORM E – Oath, Affirmation or Declaration of Election Official](#).

Hours of work are approximately 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. at the Regular Poll and vary at Advance and Special Polls.

Applicants must be available to work on November 1 – 4 and/or November 13, 2024.
